

**Reminder:** Beginning April, 2010, contractors performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities and schools built before 1978 must be EPA certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination.

The requirements apply to renovation, repair or painting activities. The rule does not apply to minor maintenance or repair activities where less than six square feet of lead-based paint is disburbed in a room or where less than 20 square feed of leadbased paint is disturbed on the exterior. Window replacement is NOT minor maintenance or repair.

Any company doing work in these homes must be certified, follow specific work practices and keep detailed records. At least one employee must be trained in these new requirements by April 2010.

For local training, **download the TJC class information sheet** on the Industry News page at www.tylerareabuilders.com. TJC classes are Feb. 5 and March 24.




